\*Anyone who holds the RBGE Diploma in Botanical Illustration is eligible to submit work for this exhibition. At the moment, there is no ESBA membership fee.

- You are invited to submit up to **4 framed works** for exhibition, which may include 1 painting which is not for sale, NFS, and/or **1 framed print**. Maximum 4 images, at least 3 of which are original works. Images which relate to the theme of 'Colours of Reality' would be excellent.
- **Mounted Prints**: You may submit mounted, wrapped and clearly identified prints with your name and the price. You can submit duplicates, but please, no more than **8 prints** in total
- You may submit up to 4 additional original small works, which may be practice or experimental pieces. These do not need to be mounted or framed, but should be enclosed in a clear cellophane envelope (see: <u>https://www.transpack.co.uk/gift-display/cellophanebags/artwork-photo-bags</u>), possibly supported by a thin cardboard sheet. The price of these items should not exceed £50.
- ESBA will unwrap your paintings for you and keep the packaging. Please provide a clearly labelled supermarket bag to help us store your packaging so that we can match the packaging to the paintings when we rewrap things ready to give back to you.
- **Cards**: a maximum of 10 per design, of up to 5 designs, that is, a total of **50 cards**. Cards can be sold in packs as well as individually provided you keep within the 50 card limit. Cards up to £5.00 per card in units of 50p. To keep accounting straightforward, no quantity discounts on sales of individual cards can be offered. Please deliver your cards in a small box identified clearly with your name.

#### ESBA COMMISSION: 10% on all sales

*LABELLING*: Framed items *must* have an accompanying swing label. The label should be attached with a string which is at least 20cm long and be taped to the top centre back of the picture. The label will contain details of the title, medium, artist, and price and must clearly identify the image

as an original or as a print as a reference for hanging the exhibition. Each picture should also have a sticky label on the back with the same information, but also to include the artist's signature.

If you return your form promptly, suitable labels will be posted out to you.

**ONLINE EXHIBITION**: We are intending to have an online exhibition on the ESBA website to run in parallel with the Dundas Street Gallery exhibition and to continue for 2-3 weeks after the physical exhibition has closed. If you want to be included in the online exhibition, you will need to provide good quality scanned or photographic images of your work. Please send these to Bill Phillips *email*: <u>doctron@btinternet.com</u> along with your submission form.

Images should be:

- of the painting or illustration unframed
- supplied as jpeg
- a minimum of 2500 pixels along the longest edge
- include the surname of the artist, followed by the title of the painting, all as part of the image filename e.g. phillips\_foxglove.jpg

You can add other details including the image size, medium, and whether prints or cards are available. Also a few sentences of biographical information or about the paintings. Potential customers will contact you by email.

**PAYMENT**: There is a £25 fee for submitting images, however many or few, to the exhibition and this should be paid in advance. You can make a BACS payment directly to ESBA at:
